WHY WE NEED CATHOLIC HEALTH CARE

We believe health care has lost its soul, and America is paying for it. We believe we can reclaim the 2000 year tradition of faithful Catholic health care, providing a kind of care that brings true healing, body, mind and spirit. MyCatholicDoctor is for everyone, not just the poor, not just the vulnerable. Everyone needs life-affirming health care.

WHAT IS CATHOLIC HEALTH CARE

The universal human experience of illness is a powerful time to recognize that 1) suffering is redemptive and an opportunity to grow in holiness, and 2) healing is a work of God, for which we can be grateful. Through illness and healing the Kingdom of God comes near to us. As healthcare professionals answering the call of Jesus Christ in Luke 10:9, our job is to 1) provide state-of-the-art, effective, ethical medical care and 2) accompany patients in their suffering and healing, so that they recognize that in this time of sickness and healing, the Kingdom of God has come near to them.

HOW WE LOST CATHOLIC HEALTH CARE

Catholics have led the world in providing life-affirming medical care. Today, pro-life Catholic health care is under attack.

- Catholic hospitals are secularizing and being sold across the United States
- Independent private practices struggle financially, especially in primary care, leading most Catholic clinicians to become employees of secular health systems, where they cannot practice faithfully and holistically.
- Most Americans do not have access to specifically Catholic health care services, including but not limited to men's and women's fertility care, mental health care, end-of-life care, sexual health, adolescent medicine, addiction care, functional medicine, and more.

RECLAIMING CATHOLIC HEALTH CARE

We are building a virtual hospital that is pro-life and pro-eternal life. Our hospital is virtual, accessible across the country, and integrated within the mainstream healthcare industry.

MyCatholicDoctor makes Catholic health care accessible throughout the United States by using both telehealth and in-person care, a network of faithful healthcare professionals, and a unique financial model that aims to accommodate different healthcare payment methods. We are committed to serving people of all faiths and creeds.

Who WE ARE

A 501(c)3 not-for-profit Foundation

We enable faithful clinicians to offer holistic,
pro-life Catholic health care.



1 We support 180 independent faithful clinicians who are offering pro-life Catholic health services throughout the United States, making pro-life Catholic health care accessible and affordable. Our clinicians provide primary care, urgent care, and multiple specialty services including but not limited to pro-life fertility care. In 2023 our clinicians provided 93% of their visits via telehealth and 7% in-person.



2 We have a donor-funded charity-care program for the uninsured and underinsured, with a goal of making pro-life Catholic health care services accessible to everyone.

3 Our clinicians offer care 24/7/365 in 48 states plus Washington, D.C. We opened in 2019 and are growing rapidly.

4 We are listed in the Official Catholic Directory, sponsored by Bishop Caggiano of the Diocese of Bridgeport, Connecticut, the home diocese of our headquarters. We are also supported by Bishop Conley of Lincoln, Nebraska, Archbishop Naumann of the Archdiocese of Kansas City, Kansas, and Bishop Coffey of the Archdiocese of the Military.



5 We offer nine essential programs that support pro-life Catholic clinicians, allowing them to practice independently and with the full voice of their faith, with the economy of scale that is necessary to compete in our current American medical marketplace. We believe the only third party in the doctor-patient relationship should be the Holy Spirit.

Our dedicated administrative team is composed of seven full-time employees, 2 part-time employees, and two volunteers, each contributing their unique skills and passion towards our shared goals.

Your support allows these 180 clinicians to continue to provide holistic, pro-life Catholic health care

All of our clinicians came to us-- we did not recruit anyone. Catholic clinicians are looking for a refuge where they are not discriminated against or oppressed because of their Catholic faith. This is what we strive for every day at MyCatholicDoctor.

Faithful Catholic clinicians often have difficulty finding employment with local health systems. As a result, many choose to open small independent practices. However, whether Catholic or secular, these small practices are paid significantly less than larger health systems. This is due to a lack of negotiation power with major insurance companies, which forces these practices to consider alternative payment models such as direct primary care, concierge services, or hybrid membership models. Catholic clinicians who want to accept insurance and practice faithfully have few options. MyCatholicDoctor strives to be the best option for faithful Catholic clinicians.

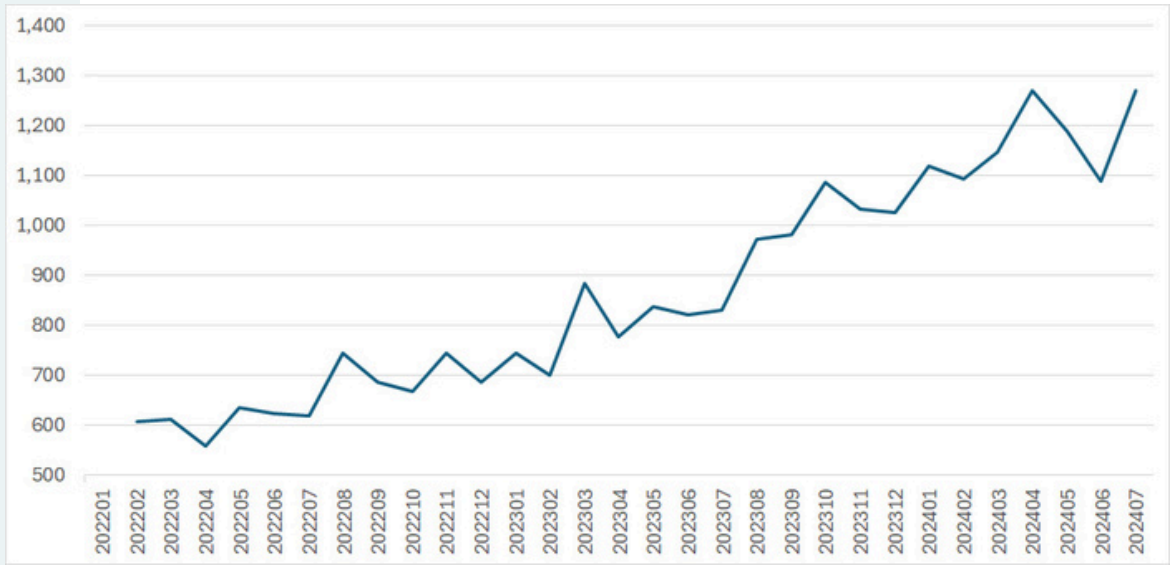

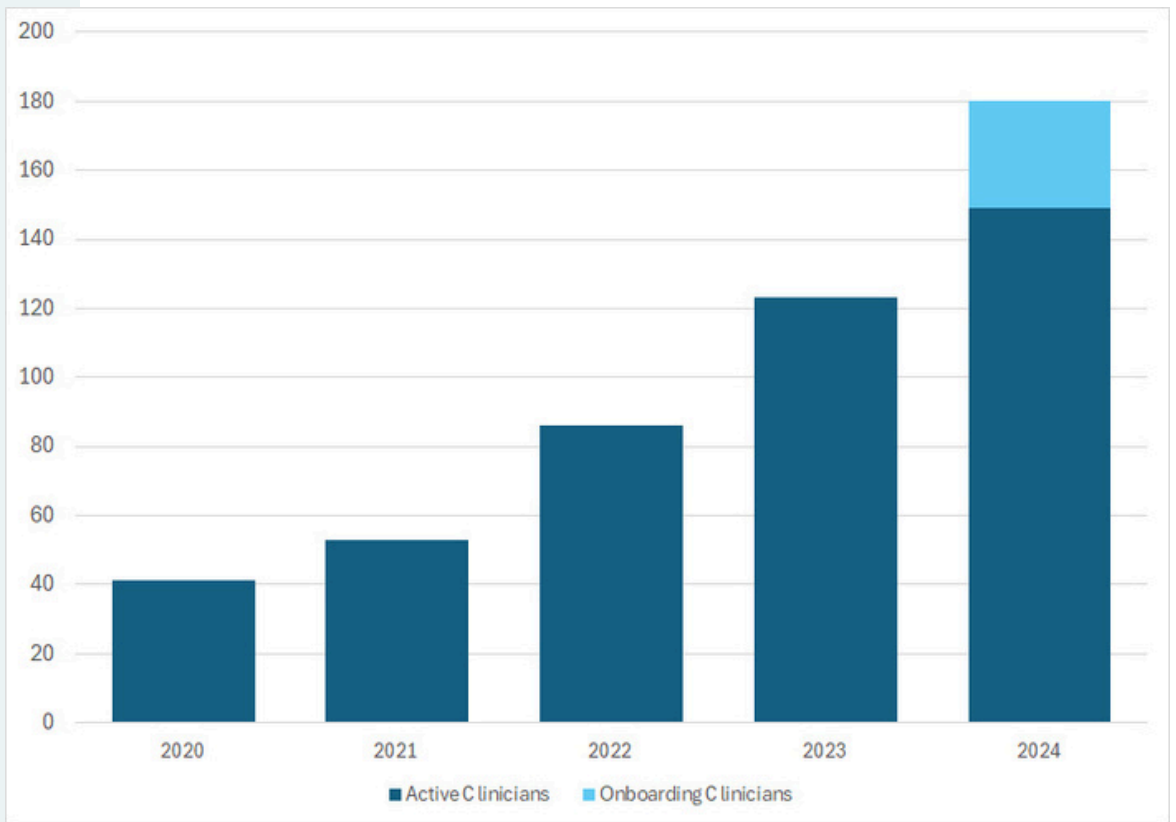

PROGRAMS

1 Charity Care

We strive to serve every patient that comes to us, regardless of their ability to pay. Many of our clinicians offer their services for free, but we still have to cover the overhead costs of malpractice insurance, technology, registration/intake, etc.

We estimate that each free visit costs us \$43 in overhead costs, even when the doctor donates his or her services.

2 Education

Public Education on Pro-life Catholic Health Care

We want all Americans to know how and why to access pro-life Catholic health care. We have effective alternatives to IVF, abortion, euthanasia and transgender care. Our clinicians donate thousands of volunteer hours writing articles and making videos about why pro-life Catholic health care is different, and how to find it. New content is published weekly and promoted through email, Google search ads, YouTube, online publications, and Catholic radio and media.

Projected cost of online media in 2025: \$50,000

Projected volunteer teaching hours donated by our clinicians in 2025: 2,000

Medical Professional Student Education

Our clinicians donate thousands of hours each year mentoring the next generation of pro-life Catholic medical professionals. The MyCatholicDoctor Foundation provides administrative support for this program as well as insurance.

2025 cost of medical professional student education: \$25,000

Projected volunteer clinical teaching hours from our clinicians in 2025: 3,000

3 Prayer for Healing

Illness brings people to prayer. Most people agree that we should pray for and with the sick, but worry that they won't find the words to pray. Our prayer ministry is here to help.

Hallow Program

MyCatholicDoctor is currently in conversation with Hallow, an app that helps people pray. We are collaborating to develop new content to help people pray for the sick. We also hope to offer a free trial of Hallow to our patients, to help them pray for healing.



Prayer Commitment of our Staff and Clinicians

MyCatholicDoctor prays the Divine Mercy Chaplet at 3 pm everyday in the Adoration Chapel in our home office. Our clinicians and staff are all asked to join us in this shared spiritual discipline by praying the Chaplet of Divine Mercy at 3 o'clock each day, in their own time zone, for the work of MyCatholicDoctor and their own intentions.

Our Prayer Team

Our prayer team consists of 18 volunteers who pray for specific intentions shared by our patients, many offer Holy Hours in front of the Blessed Sacrament for the prayer requests of our patients. Our prayer team follows up with patients by mail, if possible. A monthly Mass is offered by Father Smith for these intentions.

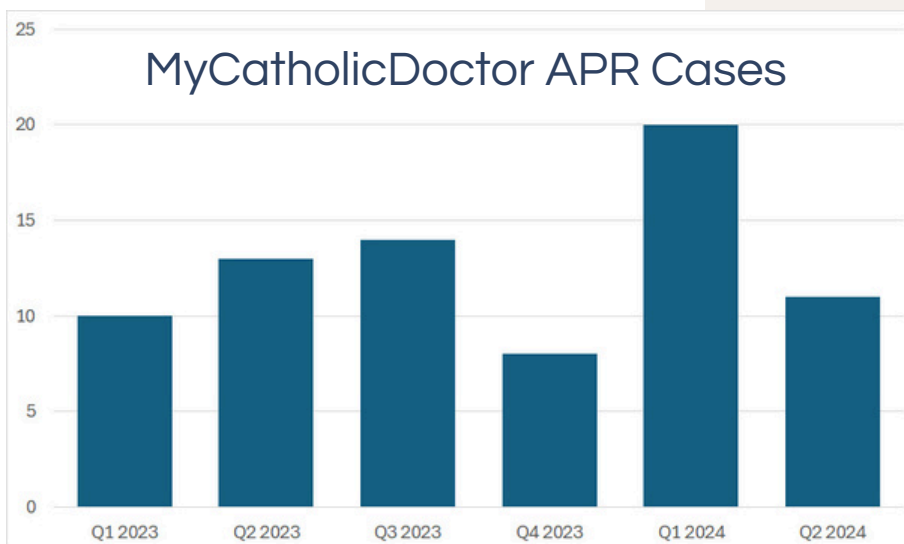
2025 cost of prayer ministry for mass offerings, postage, stationary, technology and administrative support: \$5,000



4 Abortion Pill Reversal (APR)

Abortion by medication is now the most common form of abortion in the United States. An amazing thing happens when women take these pills: many are overcome with regret. They often tell us they felt a sense of “darkness.” These women who took all the steps to get an abortion then come to us, asking for help, asking to stop the abortion. Often we are able to stop the abortion by giving these women medication and providing prompt follow-up care.

MyCatholicDoctor supports APR throughout the United States, 24/7/365.



Costs of our APR program include:

- a special rider on our malpractice insurance to cover APR
- state licensing for the physicians offering this service
- administrative support
- cost of reversal medications for women with financial need

Our clinicians donate:

- all medical time and services

2025 projected cost of MyCatholicDoctor’s APR program: \$60,000

2025 projected clinical hours donated by our APR clinicians: 370



Spotlight



Dr. Robert Chasuk, M.D., CFCMC, is a Family Physician and the Chair of our Women's Health & Fertility Care Department. He is also a full-time volunteer who oversees our national APR program and mentors young and mid-level fertility care professionals.

5 Natural Family Planning/Fertility Awareness

MyCatholicDoctor clinician Dr. Cami Jo Tice-Harouff SUED THE BIDEN ADMINISTRATION AND WON, because they tried to remove Natural Family Planning from the Affordable Care Act. Thanks to this win, NFP/FABM is covered pre-deductible and without co-pay, the same as birth control. No one should ever have to pay for Natural Family Planning in the United States.

But this win was just the beginning:

- We are working with the St. Augustine Foundation to offer no cost NFP for the uninsured and the underinsured
- We volunteer to assist with clinical research on NFP/FABM
- We FIGHT insurance companies to ensure they are paying for NFP, in accordance with the law
- We collaborate with multiple organizations to promote NFP education and awareness

2025 projected cost of NFP/FABM program: \$35,000

6 Other Pro-life Programs: alternatives to IVF, euthanasia, transgender care, and more

The MyCatholicDoctor Foundation has brought together a team of clinicians that volunteer their time as program directors for all of our pro-life programs, including Women’s Health and Fertility, Men’s Fertility, End-of-Life Care, Detransitioner care, and more. Our department chairs are not paid for their tireless work coordinating care, building programs, training colleagues, recruiting new clinicians, and working with our billing department to ensure care is covered. They depend on our administrative support, technology, and insurance to offer this essential pro-life volunteer work.

2025 projected pro-life program cost: \$30,000 along with numerous volunteer hours from our department chairs:



7 Pro-life Catholic Care for the U.S. Military

The MyCatholicDoctor Foundation worked with Bishop Coffey of the Archdiocese of the Military to ensure pro-life health care including NFP is covered by Tricare and advertised on the TRICARE website. We look forward to building this program in 2025, promoting a culture of life in our military. Costs including recruiting and credentialing pro-life TRICARE clinicians, working with TRICARE to ensure appropriate billing and reimbursement, enrolling clinicians in TRICARE and educating TRICARE staff.



2025 projected cost of military program: \$19,000

8 Advocacy for Equitable Insurance Payment for Pro-life Medical Services

The devil is in the dollars-- many insurance companies do not pay for pro-life services, even when these services save them money. For example, Restorative Reproductive Medicine and NaPro Technology are much less expensive than IVF, yet reimbursement for pro-life infertility care is barely profitable.

We fight with insurance companies to get equitable reimbursement for pro-life care. We are joining forces with the Catholic Health Care Leadership Alliance and other independent Catholic clinics across the United States to fight for "equitable reimbursement for culturally sensitive care from a pro-life Catholic Perspective."

Projected costs of this program in 2025: \$10,500

9 Opening New In-Person Clinics Across the Country

Telehealth is not enough-- people need and want in-person care. We do have a handful of small offices across the country, but we need more, and real estate is expensive. The MyCatholicDoctor Foundation recently renovated a former convent to become a medical office in Stamford, Connecticut. The lease is affordable, the diocese is happy to have a good tenant, our patients love our location, and our lovely space even includes a chapel! Because the MyCatholicDoctor Foundation is a ministry of the Catholic Church, the diocese can lease to us without having to pay unrelated business income tax. We hope to be able to replicate this process in other locations, allowing more in-person MyCatholicDoctor locations.

Cost of this program in 2025 depends on the number of new locations opened. Several locations are under consideration.

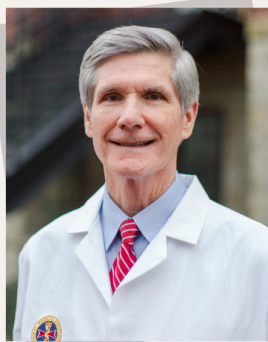

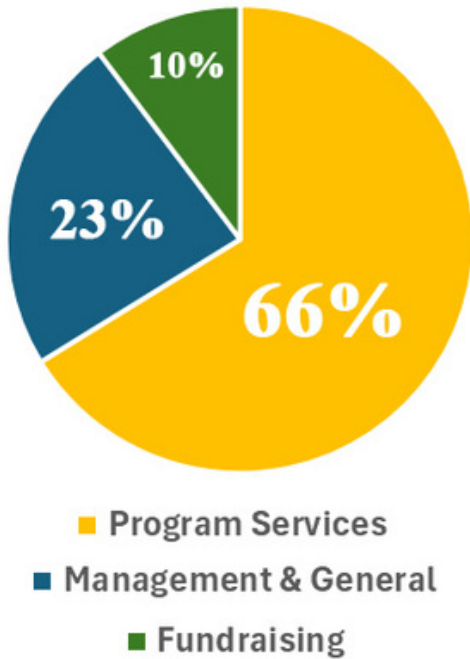

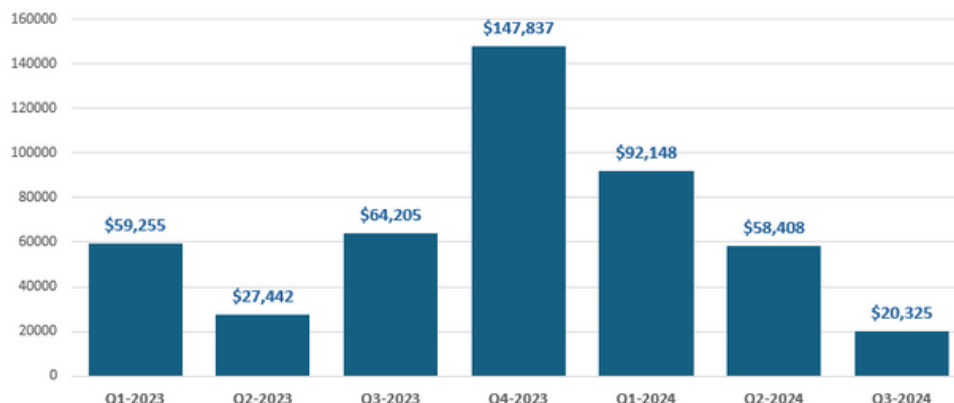
