




Abortion Pill Reversal Initiative

Patient Story: She stayed in touch with me the whole time

A quiet moment of accompaniment. A saved life.

MyCatholicDoctor gives women the chance to choose life — even after they've taken the abortion pill. The following is a reflection from one of our medical professionals who helped guide a mother through the reversal process, pregnancy, and beyond:

"A beautiful baby girl was born last year — a baby I came to know through our Abortion Pill Reversal protocol. It was touch-and-go in the beginning. Her mother experienced significant bleeding, but she stayed in contact with me throughout the pregnancy — and ever since. She's deeply grateful for the reversal and thrilled to have her daughter here and well. I'm so thankful to be able to use my license in this way — and grateful to MyCatholicDoctor for giving me the platform and support to do that."

Holy Family Initiative

LIFE-AFFIRMING FERTILITY CARE FOR MEN AND WOMEN

Too many families today are told that IVF is their only option. At MyCatholicDoctor, we offer effective infertility treatments for both men and women that respect the dignity of life and the sacredness of marriage.

Through Restorative Reproductive Medicine, The Holy Family Initiative offers clinically sound alternatives to in vitro fertilization, enabling couples to achieve pregnancy while remaining faithful to Church teaching. We partner with highly trained physicians, fertility educators, NaProTechnology, and Restorative Reproductive Medicine (RRM) specialists to offer care that addresses the root causes of infertility. We are the only organization offering Restorative Reproductive Medicine nationwide. We also bill insurance for RRM, including Medicaid and TRICARE (military).

HOW YOU CAN HELP:

- \$100,000 funds our newly upgraded electronic medical record that offers RRM technology.
- \$15,000 funds required continuing medical education in Restorative Reproductive Medicine for our healthcare professionals.
- \$10,000 funds our work with MAHA and the Heritage Foundation to promote RRM services.
- \$3,500 funds a couple struggling with infertility that is uninsured and cannot afford care.



Ashley's Story: 3 Miscarriages, 4 Babies, and a Congressional Briefing

Ashley Figueroa and her two MyCatholicDoctor healthcare professionals presented this story at a Congressional Briefing on Restorative Reproductive Medicine in September 2025.

I want to share my story of hope. During my fourth pregnancy, I miscarried. I sat in my doctor's office, devastated, desperate for answers. Instead of compassion or solutions, I was told the standard of care: nothing could be done until I experienced two more miscarriages. In other words, I would have to endure that heartbreak two more times before anyone would even begin to ask why it was happening.

I couldn't accept that. I was grieving, but I was also searching. That's when a friend told me about Restorative Reproductive Medicine. For the first time, I was heard. Symptoms that had been brushed aside for years were finally taken seriously. Through thorough testing, I finally had answers, and more importantly, a path forward.

We discovered underlying autoimmune disease, prediabetes, hormonal insufficiency, and adenomyosis-conditions that explained not only my miscarriage, but years of health struggles. My treatment plan included progesterone, metformin, evidence-based supplements, DHEA, and both diet and lifestyle changes. But most importantly, I worked together with my physician, who not only saw me as an individual but also supported each pregnancy individually. It wasn't about fitting the patient into a protocol, but shaping the protocol to fit the patient.

This proactive approach empowered me. My doctor took the time to educate me about my body, teaching me how to optimize my cycles and health—not just preconception, but during pregnancy and postpartum. For the first time, I felt like a true partner in my own care.

Holy Death Initiative

Catholic doctors will tell you that dying patients often experience a grace-filled sense of prayer, an openness to God. The dying can also experience a last temptation, a last-ditch effort of the evil one to claim their soul. In a growing number of U.S. states, assisted suicide and euthanasia are legal — and even promoted — under the banner of "death with dignity" or "medication assistance in dying (MAID)". MyCatholicDoctor's team of faithful doctors help the dying understand that true death with dignity is death in the arms of Jesus and Mary.

The Holy Death Initiative provides patients, families, and healthcare professionals with the tools they need to navigate the final journey of life with faith, clarity, and love. Our team offers medical care, moral guidance, spiritual accompaniment, and support that aligns with Church teaching on redemptive suffering, love, and the dignity of the human person.

When God Calls: Discerning End-of-Life Decisions Through Catholic Eyes

Honoring the final chapter with reverence, not fear.

Nancy, a lifelong Catholic and experienced geriatric nurse, turned to MyCatholicDoctor when her 93-year-old mother's health began to decline. She knew her mother didn't want extraordinary measures — no feeding tubes or invasive procedures — but navigating those decisions as a daughter and a nurse felt overwhelming.

Before her mother's hospitalizations, Nancy sought guidance from MyCatholicDoctor eldercare specialist Matthew Estrade. **Their conversation grounded her in both Catholic bioethics and peace of mind.** When her mother's condition worsened after multiple hospital stays, **Nancy felt prepared** to honor her mother's wishes — medically and spiritually.

Together with her siblings, she coordinated hospice care and transformed her mother's home into a space of sacred beauty: rosaries, chaplets, and an enthronement to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. **Her mother died peacefully, surrounded by faith, not fear.** "I felt like I could finally breathe and let go. The peace in that room was unmistakable."

Nancy didn't give up on care — she gave herself permission to follow God's will, fully supported by Catholic medical professionals who respected the dignity of every moment.

She hopes more families will know that a holy death is possible — one that honors the body, prepares the soul, and places full trust in God's timing. With support from MyCatholicDoctor, families can navigate end-of-life decisions with clarity, peace, and grace.



One Flesh Initiative

"...and the two shall become one flesh" - Genesis 2:24

The One Flesh Initiative equips couples and individuals with scientifically sound, Catholic-aligned fertility education and natural family planning (NFP/FABM) through our network of clinicians and certified instructors. We serve engaged couples, newlyweds, and those struggling with infertility — offering care grounded in Theology of the Body and medical excellence.

"We thought we understood marriage and fertility. Then we met our MyCatholicDoctor practitioner. It changed everything — not just our method, but our mindset."

HOW YOU CAN HELP:

- Pray for our fertility educators who donate hundreds of hours of free care and reduced-price care each year to our uninsured patients
- \$100,000 upgrades our electronic medical record to allow for integrated NFP tracking and data sharing between the couple and the NFP teacher
- \$900 trains a new fertility educator in an evidence-based method of NFP
- \$250 funds NFP for a couple that is uninsured

Learning to Trust, Learning to Chart

Sarah's Journey with MyCatholicDoctor

Sarah and her husband had never heard of natural family planning before marriage prep. She admits, "I was terrified to give up control of our fertility." But when her doctor dismissed her concerns about irregular cycles and mood swings, Sarah turned to MyCatholicDoctor.

Through virtual sessions with a Marquette Method instructor and a Catholic medical professional, she learned how to track her cycle, identify symptoms of underlying hormonal imbalance, and trust that her body wasn't broken — just misunderstood.

"I'm so grateful I trusted the Lord and said yes to something that seemed scary. My instructor explained things gently, with compassion and deep knowledge. I felt seen as a whole person — not just a diagnosis."

Sarah's story is one of many. Through education, accompaniment, and faith-rooted care, the One Flesh Initiative helps women like Sarah **reclaim their fertility — and restore joy in their marriage**.







In His Image Initiative

Today, more individuals are coming forward who regret undergoing gender transition and seek to return to their biological sex — physically, emotionally, and spiritually. The journey back is often marked by pain, isolation, and silence. At MyCatholicDoctor, we believe **no one should walk this path alone.** Our clinicians have the resources and compassion to help and accompany people on the difficult path to full restoration. Our **heroic clinicians** need **heroic support** to help these **heroic people** realize God's plan for their life.



According to the National Catholic Bioethics Center, 13,957 minors (≤17) received some form of gender-transition procedure or medication from 2019 through early 2023. One recent study of a U.S. federal insurance database identified over 107,000 adults with a gender dysphoria diagnosis. In 2024, JAMA reported that roughly 5.3 per 100,000 US adults undergo gender-affirming surgery. National cohort data indicate that permanent detransition is relatively uncommon (on the order of 1–5%).

HOW YOU CAN HELP:

- **Pray for the healthcare professionals** who offer this care; they generally offer these services "underground" without any online mention of their work.
- \$15,000 funds our work with the Centers for Medicaid and Medicare to improve coding and billing for detransition care.
- Many patients come to us with **no way to pay for their care.**





Blessed are the Poor Initiative

We strive to serve every patient who comes to us, regardless of their ability to pay. Many of our clinicians offer their services at no cost, but we still have overhead costs associated with malpractice insurance, technology, credentialing, and other expenses. We work with patients to determine their need, their ability to pay, and MyCatholicDoctor's ability to help. **Your support helps us extend the healing hands of the Divine Phsyician.**



In 2026, we project our clinicians will donate approximately **3,890 free clinical hours**

Between September 2024 and August 2025, MyCatholicDoctor provided \$70,101 in charity care grants in support of qualified patients.

Catholic Health Care Education Initiative

We are training the next generation of authentically Catholic medical professionals who are pro-life and proeternal life.

MyCatholicDoctor offers pro-life education to students in medical and nursing schools through clinical rotation opportunities and online courses. We have partnered with the University of Mary Nurse Practitioner program and the FACTS about Fertility organization, in collaboration with Georgetown Medical School. We are also in discussions with several new Catholic medical schools opening in the United States, including the Benedictine School of Osteopathic Medicine. We do not receive payment from these institutions for our educational efforts— all our teachers are volunteers.

HOW YOU CAN HELP:

- **Pray for our students and teachers**. We recommend the physician's prayer which can be found on page 13.
- \$25,000 funds a part-time Director of Medical Education for MyCatholicDoctor
- \$500 funds an online mini-course on pro-life care, such as Abortion Pill Reversal.



Pro-Life Medical Research Initiative

This initiative supports critical research advancing pro-life medical care, especially regarding Abortion Pill Reversal, Restorative Reproductive Medicine, and the STORMM study.

Effective February 1, 2026, MyCatholicDoctor will begin submitting real anonymized patient research data to the Surveillance of Treatment Outcomes for Restorative Reproductive Medicine (STORRM). The registry is a project of the International Institute for Restorative Reproductive Medicine (IIRRM), in collaboration with the University of Utah and Neofertility. This technology integration depends on our new electronic health record. We are also working with various organizations to increase the volume of research on Abortion Pill Reversal. APR research is critical for scaling APR in the United States.

HOW YOU CAN HELP:

- **Pray for Catholic medical research**, primarily through the intercession of Venerable Jerome LeJeune.
- \$100,000 funds the increase in cost of our new electronic health record (EHR).
- \$20,000 funds a part-time Clinical Research Director.



The Laborer Deserves His Wages Initiative

There is a tremendous injustice in healthcare payment systems, an injustice that few people speak about: Pro-life medical services are reimbursed by insurance payers at a tiny fraction of the amount paid for the unethical alternatives. The MyCatholicDoctor Foundation fights for equitable insurance reimbursement for life-affirming medical services, thereby reducing the need for philanthropic support.

We cannot scale pro-life health care in America unless our efforts are financially sustainable. Dr. Berchelmann and other MyCatholicDoctor professionals are working with The Heritage Foundation **to reform medical billing codes** to be inclusive of prolife medical services.

Our mission statement at MyCatholicDoctor is Luke 10:9, but we are also drawn to the passage just prior, Luke 10:7, where **Jesus speaks of the laborer deserving his wages**.

For example, abortion pill reversal is not reimbursed, but abortion is lucrative. IVF is highly reimbursed, but restorative reproductive medicine/IVF alternatives are so poorly covered by insurance that most of these providers do not accept insurance.



HOW YOU CAN HELP:

- **Pray** that the Holy Spirit gives us the right words to contribute to national policy discussions on billing and coding for pro-life health care.
- \$60,000 funds the AI billing and coding system that we need to identify payment disparities for pro-life health care.
- \$60,000 funds a key hire to spearhead this work.



Build it and They Will Come Initiative

Telehealth is not enough—we need in-person Catholic health care. In-person care is more expensive than telehealth, but we don't receive higher payments from insurance payers.

We have a handful of small offices across the country, such as the Star of the Sea clinic in rural South Dakota, pictured below, but there is a need for more, and real estate is expensive.

We are currently operating or opening brick-and-mortar offices in Pennsylvania, North Carolina, Montana, Oregon, Connecticut, Louisiana, and other locations.

HOW YOU CAN HELP:

- **Donate real estate**, especially medical office space in the locations listed above.
- Donate medical equipment.
- \$7,000 funds vision testing equipment for pediatric practices.
- \$5,000 funds viral testing equipment for our rural clinic locations.

After years of work by the MyCatholicDoctor Foundation, we are delighted to announce that TRICARE and the Defense Health Agency are now paying for Natural Family Planning, nationwide. This means members of our military, as well as their dependents, now have access to natural family planning that is covered by their insurance.

TRICARE even changed its website to reflect access to NFP.


But we need your help. At present, TRICARE recipients have little to no access to Restorative Reproductive Medicine/prolife infertility care. We continue to work with MAHA, the Defense Health Agency, and TRICARE to improve access to and reimbursement for pro-life health services. We are making slow but steady progress, working with everyone from leaders who make decisions to contractors who modify the coding logic so that claims are finally paid.

HOW YOU CAN HELP:

- **Pray for our members of the military**, their families at home, and especially those who do not have access to prolife healthcare. We suggest praying through the intercession of Venerable Emil Kapaun.
- \$10,000 funds the work of our TRICARE team for one year. This team includes a volunteer retired military member, our Director of Billing, and our Medical Director.
